PRESS RELEASE- MIELE DELHI POLO SEASON 2009 **THE BARODA CUP (12 GOALS)**

New Delhi, Wednesday, 18 November 2009. JPC beat Tiger-Sona by 7 goals to 5 and Jindal-Elevation beat Cavalry by 8 goals to 5 in the league matches of the Baroda Cup (12 Goals) Polo Tournament.

The Delhi Fall Polo Season 2009 was sponsored by MIELE, a German maker of luxury home appliances.

The first match was played between JPC and Tiger-Sona, in which JPC beat Tiger-Sona by 7 goals to 5. Abhimanyu Pathak opened the account for Tiger-Sona and Vishal Singh converted a 60 yard penalty while Angad Kalaan opened the account by converting a 60 yard penalty and Uday Kalaan scored another goal for JPC. In the 2nd chukker Vishal Singh converted two 40 yard penalties into goal while Angad Kalaan again converted a 60 yard penalty. Some how the 3rd chukker was not in favour of Tiger-Sona in which they could not score any goal whereas Angad Kalaan scored 2 goals (one field goal and one conversion of 60 yard penalty). The score was 5 goals to 4 in favour of JPC. In the last chukker Vishal Singh scored a goal for Tiger-Sona to reduce the margin 5 to 6 while Angad Kalaan converted two penalties (one spot hit and one 60 yard penalty) for JPC to insure the victory. Scorers for JPC were – Angad Kalaan (6), Uday Kalaan (1). Scorers for Tiger-Sona were – Vishal Singh (4), Abhimanyu Pathak (1).

The second match was played between Jindal-Elevation to Cavalry, in which Jindal-Elevation beat Cavalry by 8 goals to 5. Maj Ravi Rathore opened the account for Cavalry by converting a 40 yard penalty while Miguel Saragia opened the account for Jindal-Elevation by converting a spot hit into goal, Vickey Nihalani scored another goal and Miguel Saragia converted a 30 yard penalty. In the 2nd chukker Maj Ravi Rathore again converted a 60 yard penalty for Cavalry while Simran Shergill converted a 60 yard penalty for Jindal-Elevation. In the 3rd chukker both teams scored 2 goal each. The score was 6 goals to 4 in favour of Jindal-Elevation. In the last chukker Simran Shergill and Miguel Saragia scored one goal each for Jindal-Elevation to increase their lead while Lt Col Navjit Sandhu converted a spot hit to reduced the margin. Scorers for Jindal-Elevation were – Simran Shergill (3), Miguel Saragia (3), Bhawani Singh Kalvi (1), Vickey Nihalani (1). Scorers for Cavalry were – Maj Ravi Rathore (4), Lt Col Navjit Sandhu (1).
