PRESS RELEASE- MIELE DELHI POLO SEASON 2009 THE BARODA CUP (12 GOALS)

New Delhi, Thursday, 19 November 2009. Tiger-Sona beat Drakon-Sahgal Stud by 7 goals to 5 ½ and Jindal-Elevation beat Navy-Tiger by 8 goals to 6 ½ in the last round league matches of the Baroda Cup (12 Goals) Polo Tournament played today at the Army Equestrian Centre Ground, Delhi Cantt.

The Delhi Fall Polo Season 2009 was sponsored by MIELE, a German maker of luxury home appliances.

The first match was played between Tiger-Sona and Drakon-Sahgal Stud in which Sahgal Stud beat Tiger-Sona by 7 goals to 5 ½. Shamsheer Ali find the first find goal for Drakon-Sahgal Stud by converting a 60 yard penalty while Vishal Singh opened the account for Tiger-Sona in 2nd chukker and Samir Suhag scored 3 brilliant goals (one 40 yard penalty, one spot hit penalty and one field goal). Samir Suhag again converted a 60 yard penalty in 3rd chukker and Sunjay Kapur added one more goal to their score line. Drakon-Sahgal Stud could not score any goal in 2nd and 3rd chukker but Gaurav Sahgal and Shamsheer Ali scored two goals each in the 4th chukker to reduce the margin while Abhimanyu Pathak scored one goal for Tiger-Sona to increase their lead by 7 goals to 5 ½. Scorers for Tiger-Sona were – Samir Suhag (4), Vishal Singh (1), Abhimanyu Pathak (1), Sunajay Kapur (1). Scorers for Darkon-Sahgal Stud were Shamsheer Ali (3), Gaurav Sahgal (2) started with ½ goal on handicap.

The second match was played between Jindal-Elevation and Navy-Tiger, in which Jindal-Elevation beat Navy-Tiger by 8 goals to 6 1/2. Vickey Nihalani opened the account for Jindal-Elevation and Miguel Saragia added one more goal in the 1st chukker while Manupal Godara converted a 40 yard penalty for Navy-Tiger who started with 1 ½ goal on handicap advantage. In the 2nd chukker both teams scored 2 goal each. 3rd chukker was not in favour of Navy-Tiger in which they could not score any goal while Jindal-Elevation scored 3 goals in this chukker. In the 4th chukker Manupal Godara scored 2 goals (one 60 yard penalty, one field goal) while Simran Shergill converted a 60 yard penalty for Jindal-Elevation. Scorers for Jindal-Elevation were – Simran Shergill (4), Miguel Sarigia (2), Bhawnai Singh Kalvi (1), Vickey Nihalani (1). Scorers for Navy-Tiger were – Manupal Godara (3), Dhruvpal Godara (1), Lt A Panchan (1) and started with 1 ½ goal on handicap.
