NAVY-TIGER WILL MEET JINDAL-ELEVATION IN THE FINALS OF THE BARODA CUP (12 GOALS)

New Delhi. Saturday, 21 November 2009. Navy-Tiger beat Drakon-Sahgal Stud by 6 goals to 4 ½ and Jindal-Elevation beat Tiger-Sona by 5 goals to 3 in the semi final matches of the Baroda Cup (12 Goals) Polo Tournament played today at the Jaipur Polo Ground, New Delhi.

The Delhi Fall Polo Season 2009 was sponsored by MIELE, a German maker of luxury home appliances.

The first semi final was played between Navy-Tiger and Drakon-Sahgal Stud, in which Navy-Tiger beat Drakon-Sahgal Stud by 6 goals to 4 ½. Lt Cdr Akhil Sirohi opened the account for Navy-Tiger and Cdr AP Singh scored another goal while Shamsheer Ali scored first field goal for Drakon-Sahgal Stud who had a ½ goal of handicap. In the 2nd chukker both teams scored one goal each. In the 3rd chukker Baljinder Dhillon scored a goal for Drakon-Sahgal Stud while Cdr AP Sing and Manupal Godara scored one goal each for Navy-Tiger. The score was 5 goals to 3 ½ in favour of Navy-Tiger. In the last chukker Shamsheer Ali converted a spot hit to reduced the margin 4 ½ to 5 but Dhruvpal Godara scored a brilliant goal for Navy-Tiger to make sure their victory and entered in the finals of Baroda Cup. Scorers for Navy-Tiger were – Cdr AP Singh (2), Lt Cdr Akhil Sirohi (2), Manupal Godara (1), Dhruvpal Godara (1). Scorers for Drakon-Sahgal Stud were – Shamsheer Ali (3), Baljindear Dhillon (1).

The second semi final was played between Jindal-Elevation and Tiger-Sona which was a low scoring match but played at a fast pace. Bhawani Singh Kalvi opened the account for Jindal-Elevation while Vishal Singh opened the account for Tiger-Sona by converting a spot hit into goal. In the 2nd chukker Miguel Sagaria converted a 30 yard penalty for Jindal-Elevation while Abimanyu Pathak scored a goal for Tiger-Sona. In the 3rd chukker Vishal Singh again converted a 30 yard penalty for Tiger-Sona while Bhawani Singh Kalvi scored a goal for Jindal-Elevation. The score was 3 – 3 at the end of 3rd chukker. In the last chukker Miguel Saragia again converted a 30 yard penalty to increase Jindal-Elevation lead. Despite their doing their best the Tiger-Sona could not score any goal while Satinder Garcha scored a goal for Jindal-Elevation to ensure their victory and entered in the finals of the Baroda Cup. Scorers for Jindal-Elevation were – Miguel Saragia (2), Bhawani Singh Kalvi (2), Satinder Garcha (1). Scorers for Tiger-Sona were – Vishal Singh (2), Abhimanyu Pathak (1).
