MAHARAJA HARI SINGH MEMORIAL CUP (12 GOALS)

New Delhi. Tuesday, November 03, 2009. The third tournament of Miele Delhi Fall Polo Season 2009, Maharaja Hari Singh Memorial Cup (12 goals) started today with 6 teams participating in this tournament. Six teams divided into two pools (Pool A – Cavalry, Equisport-Classic, Jindal-Elevation and Pool B – Sahgal Stud-Tiger, JPC- Horse & Wagon, Navy). The tournament is being played as round robin with cross semi finals format. The finals will be played on Sunday, 08 Nov 2009 at the Jaipur Polo Ground.

The first league match of the tournament was played at Army Equestrian Centre between Equisport-Classic and Jindal-Elevation of Pool A which was draw at a score of 7 each. Miguel Saragia of Jindal-Elevation opened the account by converting 40 yard penalty while Shamsheer Ali converted two penalties (40 and 60 yard respectively) for Equisport-Classic and Abhimanyu Pathak added one more goal in the 1st chukker. In the 2nd chukker Miguel Saragia again converted two 40 yard penalties and Satinder Garcha scored another goal for Jindal-Elevation while Adhiraj Singh scored one goal for Equisport-Classic. In the 3rd chukker Shamsheer Ali scored 2 goals (one 40 yard penalty one field goal) for Equisport-Classic whereas Jindal-Elevation unable to score any goal. The score was 6 – 4 in favour of Equisport-Classic. Abhimanyu Pathak scored a goal during starting of 4th chukker to increase their lead by 7 goals to 4 but Jindal-Elevation team came strongly and converted three penalties (one 40, one 30 by Miguel Saragia and one 60 by Simran Shergill) and equaled the score to 7 all. Scorers for Equisport-Classic were – Shamsheer Ali (4), Abhimanyu Pathak (2), Adhiraj Singh (1). Scorers for Jindal-Elevation were – Miguel Saragia (5), Simran Shergill (1), Satinder Garcha (1).

The second match of the tournament was played between JPC-Horse & Wagon and Navy of Pool B in which JPC- Horse & Wagon beat Navy by 7 goals to 4. Manupal Godara was lone scorer for JPC- Horse & Wagon who scored all 7 goals (3 goals in 1st chukker, 2 goal in 2nd chukker and one goal each in 3rd and 4th chukker) whereas Navy team scored one goal each in every chukker (1st goal by Lt Cdr Akhil Sirohi in 1st chukker, Angad Kalaan converted two 40 yard penalties in 2nd and 3rd chukker and scored one field goal in 4th chukker).
