PRESS RELEASE- MIELE DELHI POLO SEASON 2009
JINDAL-ELEVATION WILL MEET EQUISPORT-CLASSIC
IN THE FINALS OF MAHARAJA HARI SINGH MEMORIAL CUP (12
GOALS)

New Delhi. Saturday, 07 November 2009. The Delhi Fall Polo Season 2009 was sponsored by MIELE, a German maker of luxury appliances. The semi finals of Maharaja Hari Singh Memorial Cup (12 Goals) were played today at the Jaipur Polo Ground, New Delhi. Jindal-Elevation beat Navy by 12 goals to 3 and Equisprot-Classic beat JPC-Horse & Wagon by 8 goals to 7.

The first semi final matches were played between Jindal-Elevation and Navy which was a one sided affair from the start. Angad Kalaan converted a 40 yard penalty to open the account for Navy while Simran Shergill scored 2 quick goals to take the Jindal-Elevation into lead. Miguel Saragia scored one goal to increase the lead 3 to 1 at the end of 1st chukker. Bhawani Kalvi scored 2 goals in the 2nd chukker while Navy could not score any goal in this chukker. 3rd chukker was totally in favour of Jindal-Elevation in which Miguel Saragia and Bhawani Kalvi scored 3 and 1 goal respectively while Lt Cdr Akhil Sirohi was able to score one goal only for Navy. The score was 2 – 9 in favour of Jindal-Elevation. In the last chukker Jindal-Elevation again scored 3 goals with Satinder Garcha, Bhawani Kalvi and Simran Shergill while Lt Col Akhil Sirohi converted a 30 yard penalty for Navy to reduced the margin 3 to 12. Scorers for Jindal-Elevation were Satinder Garcha (1), Bhawani Kalvi (4), Miguel Saragia (4), Simran Shergill (3). Scorers for Navy were - Angad Kalaan (1), Lt Cdr Akhil Sirohi (2)..

The second semi finals of the tournament was played between JPC-Horse & Wagon and Equisport-Classic it was a great fight and played at great pace. Shamsheer Ali opened the account for Equisport-Classic by converting a 30 yard penalty while Manupal Godara opened the account for JPC-Horse & Wagon by converting a 30 yard penalty in the 1st chukker. 2nd chukker was not in favour of Equisprot-Classic in which Shamsheer Ali was able converted one 30 yard penalty while Manupal Godara scored 2 goals (one 30 yard and one field goal) and Bhuchi Prakash converted a spot hit into goal JPC-Horse & Wagon. the 3rd chukker Shamsheer Ali scored 3 goals for Equisport-Classic to take the lead for the first time by 5 – 4 but Uday Kalaan scored a goal to equalize the score 5-5 and Manupal Godara converted a 30 yard penalty in the dying minute of the chukker for JPC-Horse & Wagon and took their lead once again by 6-5. The last chukker started with a quick field goal by Mr Shamsheer Ali and leveled the score. 6 all. Both teams played superbly, Shamsheer Ali converted a 60 yard penalty and Abhimanyu Pathak scored a brilliant goal to increase their team's lead 8 to 6 but during dying seconds of the match Manupal Godara again converted a 30 yard penalty for JPC-Horse & Wagon to reduce the margin 7 – 8. Scorers for Equisprot-Classic were – Shamsheer Ali (7), Abhimanyu Pathak (1). Scorers for JPC-Horse & Wagon were – Manupal Godara (5), Uday Kalaan (1), Buchi Prakash (1).

The finals will be played between Jindal-Elevation and Equisport-Classic tomorrow at the Jaipur Polo Ground, New Delhi at 1530 hrs.
